Introduction

Project Shitalta was a community service initiative organized by the Interact Club of Central Butwal to provide relief to devotees from the intense summer heat. The project focused on distributing drinking water and juices to devotees visiting Devsthal Mandir, ensuring access to refreshment and hydration during their visit.

The project was conducted on 10 August 2026 in collaboration with the Rotaract Club of Tinau Butwal and Leo Club of Butwal Kshitiz.
