Introduction:

From August 22nd to August 24th, 2026 the Interact Club of Narayani Public School with the Interact Club of Little Flower School did a great job organizing "Axis MUN 1.0". The three-day Model United Nations conference was created to give people a chance to get involved in diplomacy thinking deeply and learning about international relations. There were six committees and more than 170 excited participants. The event wanted to help young people learn more, about the world talk about global issues and get better at speaking in public, negotiating and leading.

About "Axis MUN 1.0"

Summary:

Axis MUN1.0 began on August 22 with an opening ceremony. The executive board and organizing committee explained committee rules, parliamentary procedures and conference agendas to delegates. For three days delegates in six committees debated, held caucuses and drafted resolutions to address complex global issues. Executive board members ran the sessions well ensuring dialogue remained constructive and all 170 + delegates participated fully. On the day committee draft resolutions were presented and voted on followed by a closing ceremony that honored outstanding delegates for their diplomacy and debate skills. The event concluded with the organizing team thanking all participating clubs, executive board members and delegates for their work and collaboration.

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Feedback

Axis MUN 1.0 received feedback from delegates, executive boards and school authorities. Participants said the conference offered a learning environment helping them build confidence in public speaking and resolution writing. Faculty advisors and guests praised the Interact Club of Narayani Public School and the Interact Club of Little Flower School for their coordination professional management of large committee sizes and high standard of debate. Attendees noted that the collaborative effort made the experience memorable and set a benchmark for MUN conferences in the region.

Conclusion

Axis MUN 1.0 concluded as a benchmark joint initiative for the Interact Club of Narayani Public School and the Interact Club of Little Flower School. By successfully hosting 6 committees and over 170 delegates, the project fulfilled its mission to empower youth with leadership qualities, global perspectives, and diplomatic problem-solving skills.
