Summary:

Volunteers hurried out to bring relief items, emergency food, clean water and simple first-aid kits to people who had lost their homes. In addition skilled volunteers and Red Cross staff taught families in areas how to stay safe and gave them urgent help. All the teams kept working making sure they reached as many houses as possible. The initiative ended with a joint review meeting where the main leaders said a big thank you to every partner and volunteer for their caring work, during the crisis.

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Feedback

The relief effort brought gratitude from the people of Pulchowk. Local residents and community leaders spoke with thanks for the swift action taken during a difficult time. Families who were affected said they truly appreciated the response and the timely arrival of food, water and medical supplies when they needed them most. Partner groups like the MRR Disaster Management Committee, the Red Cross and Gen-Z Chitwan gave praise to the Interactors. They highlighted how well the team worked together how disciplined everyone stayed and how actively they stepped in to manage the crisis.
