Child's Education and Growth

Introduction:

The Child's Education and Growth project is an ongoing educational initiative organized by the Interact Club of Ullens to support the foundational education of underprivileged children. The project focuses on providing regular tutoring sessions to Grade 2 students through online classes. The initiative aims to strengthen students' basic English skills while encouraging Interact members to actively participate in community service and educational development. The first session was conducted on August 10, 2026, through Google Meet, with 7 Grade 2 students and 7 Interact Club volunteers participating. The tutoring session lasted approximately one hour and focused on vocabulary, grammar, and reading.

Project Summary

The first session of the Child's Education and Growth project was conducted virtually through Google Meet. Seven Interact Club volunteers participated in the session and provided academic support to seven Grade 2 students from a specific school. The session primarily focused on English language

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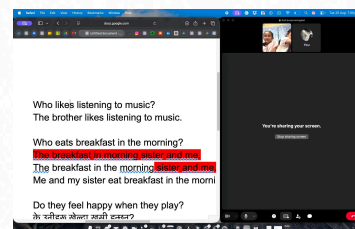
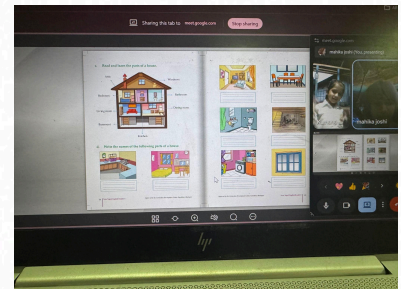
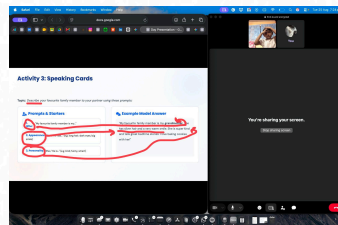


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development, covering vocabulary, basic grammar, and reading. Volunteers used a Canva presentation, an online book, and a handbook as learning resources. The volunteers guided the students through the lessons and assisted them with exercises and corrections throughout the session. As the project is designed to be ongoing, tutoring sessions will continue regularly depending on volunteer availability, with sessions planned for every day when possible and at least several times a week. Through consistent academic support, the project aims to help students strengthen their educational foundation and develop greater confidence in their learning. One of the main challenges encountered during the online session was maintaining the students' attention and effectively monitoring and correcting their work. The virtual format made it more difficult for volunteers to ensure that all students remained engaged and received individual assistance. Despite this, the volunteers adapted their teaching methods and used visual and digital resources to make the session more interactive. The project currently involves 7 student beneficiaries and 7 Interact volunteers, with the intention of continuing and expanding the initiative through regular tutoring sessions.
